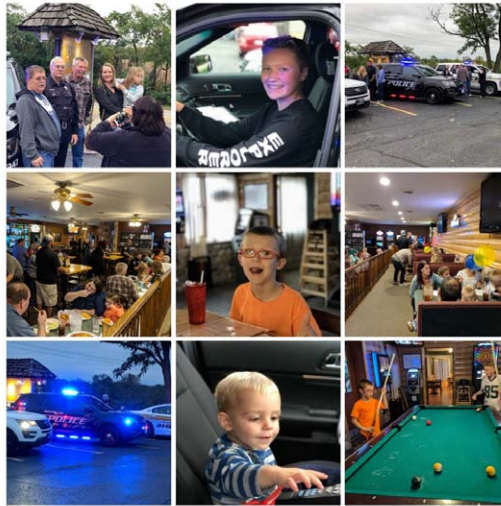

### **Fall Leaf Pickup**

Fall Leaf Pickup will be done the week of November 12th. Please have your leaves down to the street by 6 AM Monday.

### **Leaf Burning**

Leaf burning *is not permitted* in the Village of McCullom Lake. Violators will receive one warning, then will be ticketed for continued offenses.

### **Fireworks**
